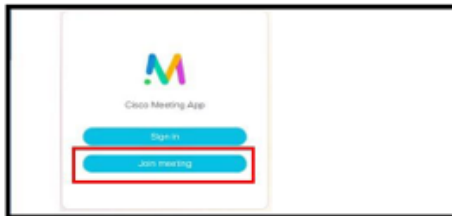

Type, "join.fairview.org" and press Enter.

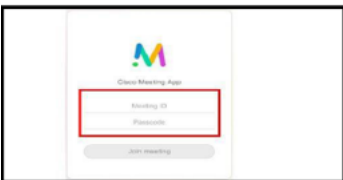
**DO NOT CLICK Sign In-Only Click Join Meeting**
